1) Minutes of last meeting - 9th January 2014 - agreed

2) Chairman's Report -

Sandilands

After a long delay the Ladies showers should get screens and curtains in the next few weeks. We are sharing the cost with Hockey. Probably £250

The choir are organising an informal concert open to all clubs on Saturday 28th June. £10 per head including buffet.

The Nursery is planning to go full time next year which should improve the clubs cash flow.

The next major project will be to improve the Hall. The first step being to find out how much of the floor needs to be replaced.

3) Membership Secretary's Report.

255 Members (235 paid 19 life 1 Expat). : a club record we believe

97 Female 158 Male

40 new members since September.

46 Dropped out (16 definitely left, 20 Not paid - almost certainly left, 10 may rejoin)

4) Kit Report

New kit has arrived. It is significantly more expensive than our previous suppliers – Hexx – who went bankrupt. For instance the overall cost to us of a club vest is now about £16 and a long-sleeved T-shirt is about £21.

We agreed to subsidise these costs to our members' benefit – so we will charge £12 for vests, £18 for long and short sleeved t-shirts, £20 for hoodies.

Striders who submitted an entry for the new logo competition will be a free vest.

5) Treasurer's Report

Reported that swimming was making a small profit.

Agreed that we could afford to make the above subsidies on the sale of club kit.

6) Club runs

Mile Time Trial – will resume on the last Wednesday of each month at about 7.10 p.m. First one will be on 30th April

Robin to look into organising a summer self-timed handicap of about 5K in Shirley Hills.

7) Socials

Feedback to Hannah:

This is going well. Split between what food is favourite so likely to alternate between pizza and fish & chips.

Christmas party

Of those who responded about why they did NOT attend last year's do many said this was because they felt the clubhouse hall was cold and lacks atmosphere. Others felt that having it at the clubhouse did not make it feel 'special'.
