### **Chairman's Report**

#### **1 Sandilands**

Hopefully a nursery will start, after Easter which will solve Sandilands financial problems for the time being.

#### **2 CHM**

Nice-works are doing all the upfront admin, entry on the day timing and results. Kathy Burke from Nice -Works will be Race Director, Robin will be Course Director.

Striders have to recruit and organise marshals for support.

Striders are to organise toilets, pa, radios.

20 volunteers from striders so far.

The ATC have offered a group of cadets to man the water stations, Running Sisters are doing the baggage tent.

The charities that will benefit from CHM were discussed, but no agreements have been made to either charities or distribution of funds.

Sandilands receives £2000 as a contribution for the hire of the premises for the day.

#### **3 Development Fund**

Striders have bought 20 tickets so far. 10 from the club and 10 from individuals

It would be good to get another 20 striders individuals to buy a ticket; we would then be close to the Choir who usually have about 50.

#### **4 Yoga**

Demand was much higher than expected. We will have two sessions at least for next few weeks at £5/head we only need 16 to break even for two sessions or 9 for a single session. The club has paid £45 for the first session and £49.99 for a Bluetooth speaker. We should get it all back plus some more in the next month. Tony and Corrine will manage the hall access and money with Robin as reserve. A booking system will be set up.

### **Membership Secretary's Report.**

Life members were emailed to ask if they wished to remain as competitive members.

Some offered to pay the £13, but it was agreed that this would be raised at the next AGM along with whether to offer the non-competitive option to everyone else.

Out of 20 life members half are non- competitive.

Fees from April will be £23 - £10 for Striders plus £13 affiliation. Anyone applying from August onwards will just pay for the following year.

The next social will be the London Marathon social. There has been no update on a replacement for Hannah. Mick will sort out a date for a quiz night. Beatrice will look at doing a Triathlon talk which is offered by England Triathlon and could be done after a Wednesday night run.

### **Sunday runs and other events**

The date proposed for the Switchback is Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> September, Mick will confirm with Deborah. Tony will be heading up the Race for Life this Year, taking over from John Ralf. It was suggested that additional training sessions for both the ladies and men's x country teams would be organised during the summer on an invitational basis, to try and encourage the teams and recruit new team members.

### **Triathlon**

Beatrice will start to organise bike rides and open water swims as the triathlon season starts in May.

### **AOB**

Krzystof to investigate purchasing new light weight flags, with the new logo. Also, tents with the logo on, to take to races.

It was noted that the club timing clock was lent out to various charities which held races in Lloyds park.
