## SOC Committee Meeting – 14<sup>th</sup> January 2019– Spreadeagle – 7.30pm

- 1. Chairman & Sandilands TF
  - a. Chairman's Report
    - First aid training course venue for Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> Feb is now fully arranged and confirmed with Royal Russell via Katherine Selby and all 12 places filled.
    - ii. Saturday 2nd March Ladies' last Surrey League XC and Men's East Surrey League both at Lloyd Park – Sue Turner advised that bar may be open anyway if hockey season is still on. If the bar is not open due to hockey Sue is amenable to opening if we can assure reasonable numbers. TF to check if Sandilands bar is open
    - iii. Sunday April 28<sup>th</sup> Sandilands bar is booked from 6pm for annual post-marathon drinks.
  - b. Sandilands Report.
    - i. TF attended second Sandilands committee meeting on 8<sup>th</sup> Jan.
    - ii. Sandilands ended the year in a reasonably healthy position financially and there are no plans to increase fees in 2019 for yoga hall rental or our club subscription.
    - iii. TF has sent a reminder mail to Sandilands Committee members to forward on to their clubs that yoga is available to all including social members.
    - iv. With regard to the new outer doors and what is now the old outer door, a new single clubhouse key has now been issued to all Striders keyholders. In accordance with a request from Roger Hurrion, chair of Sandilands, an individually signed register of all our keyholders and their telephone contact details has been submitted (this request applied to all Sandilands Clubs).
    - v. Defibrillator now in bar. An evening to be arranged to go through how it works. TF advised that we have a sports specific first aid course coming up for Striders including use of defibrillator. TF will attend Sandilands evening if possible along with anyone else who wants to go along (I'm assured the procedure is not complicated) will also feedback to Striders first aiders as to where it is, procedures etc.
  - c. Croydon Half Marathon
    - i. Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> March Sandilands hall now booked for 8am onwards for CHM. We will need to open up ourselves and un-alarm hall. The main gates at car park entrance will need to be opened up fully – TF has a raft of keys for this which I need to test in advance. Not sure if gates will need to be opened and closed day before if other equipment eg Portaloos need to be positioned the evening before. TBC whether bar will be open. Sue Turner advised there were very few customers last year as people were drinking tea and coffee from stalls set up in the

ground. It is also Mothers Day this year so likely to be even less people staying around. TF to discuss further with James Burree as regards viability of opening bar.

- ii. Following accounts update from Ruth Pearson at upcoming meeting James Burree (chair of CHM sub committee) and TF have arranged to have a catch up re CHM in general and looking at estimated figures for entry income, costs and subsequent charitable donations plus now above-mentioned issues.
- iii. As of 2 weeks ago we had 177 entries up on the past few years. TF to discuss with James publicising/encouraging sharing of CHM entry information with the club, using Niceworks' flyer as promotional material.
- 2. Secretary MT
  - a. London marathon volunteers. MT confirmed that he would be in control of the London Marathon volunteers this year. VMLM have asked if we could cover an additional section of the course, requiring 50 volunteers in total. MT to publicise to club earlier than normal.
  - b. MT to send generic email to club re EA Coaching.

  - a. Subs update 230 paid up. 140 non payers. SW to target non-payers.

- 4. Treasurer RP
  - a. Banking responsibilities. TF has completed all necessary forms. RP requested an additional signatory so MT agreed to this. RP to let MT know what he needs to do.
  - b. Wings confirmed as sponsor for Croydon Half Marathon. Winning Margin confirmed as providing T Shirts.
- 5. Socials LF
  - a. CroyWall Feb 1<sup>st</sup>. LF secured a reduced rate for this and it has generated a fair amount of interest. LF to forward details.
  - b. Wednesday Club talks and events. The Winning Margin event was popular and they are returning on 30<sup>th</sup> Jan. A navigational talk is planned for 23<sup>rd</sup> Jan. Other potential topics (eg nutrition, ultra, S&C, EA speaker on mental welfare -NJ will look into EA mental welfare topic. BS re Triathlon England.
- 6. Communication Officer JOM
  - a. Club Magazine It was agreed to look at better re-use of magazine articles. JOM to talk to AD re this and investigate better linking/re-use of articles. , with Alan
  - b. Striders noticeboard and use of JOM to fill the board
  - c. Owen Trophy. Look at bringing season closer in line with membership year rather than 1st Dec to 30th Nov. It was agreed to shorten the 2019 Owen Trophy year for 2019 from 1<sup>st</sup> Dec to 31<sup>st</sup> October. Shorten the year for 2019 til end of October. JM to update rules and email club.
  - d. London Marathon Club Draw. Clarify & update rules on the website. MT to update rules on website.

- e. Issues communicated from groups runs & group leaders.
  - i. runners falling off the back of groups and not letting anyone know, or finishing a run early and not letting anyone know / difficulty in accounting for everyone lack of looping.... TF to send reminder email.
- 7. Kit Officer NJ

- 8. Club Runs All

- 11. Triathlon & multisports
  - a. It was agreed to re-affiliate as a club with the BTF (British Triathlon Federation) BS to liaise with RP
  - b. The Striders only Strength & Conditioning classes at MyPT have started on a Thursday. BS to continue to promote to Striders.
- 12. Marathon Training
  - a. Structured Sunday Marathon Runs. KK suggested that we revisit this topic of specific pace targeting during long runs after the spring marathons.
- 13. parkrun age graded competition
  - a. Suggestion to keep as annual tie in to Christmas? The Committee decided to look for a second date in the summer. MT to look at calendar.
- 14. XC handicap
  - a. Finding a third date has proved very difficult MT to look at calendar for all summer handicaps/events and report back.
- 15. Ultra award for 19/20 season. It was thought too difficult to quantify this so this is on hold for the time being.
- 16. Website
  - a. The Striders wordpress theme, as a bespoke version, cannot be updated and there is a risk of the site falling down. JM will have a look at some ideas and costings for updates to the website for the next committee meeting.
- 17. B&B Mob Match
  - a. KK mentioned that horses in the field bolted through the field through a gated path at the start area and almost hit some spectators/runners getting ready. He has requested that the organisers think about safety and secure the horses for future mob matches.
