- 1. Chairman & Sandilands TF
  - a. Roger Hurrion, Sandilands Chair, to give a defibrillator demonstration after the final road handicap on the 3<sup>rd</sup> July.
  - b. The next Sandilands improvement planned is better lighting in the car park. TBA when this is to start.
- 2. Secretary MT
  - a. After 5 years Krzysztof Klidzia has stepped down from the Committee and from his role as men's XC manager. MT thanked KK for his years of service as the Runners' Representative for faster runners and for his XC manager role. This leaves three vacancies on the Committee for two Runners' Representatives and a Committee Representative. MT to email club with details of Committee vacancies. Regular male XC runners will be canvassed for interest in the XC manager role.
- 3. Membership SW
  - a. 326 members. SW to update detail.
  - b. NJ requested access to EA membership details in order to be able to complete XC entry forms. SW to provide access
- 4. Treasurer RP
  - a. RP shared current states of accounts. Yoga shortfall for 2019 was discussed. It was agreed to promote until the AGM and review at the AGM. MT to approach yoga teacher, L, for more promotional ideas.
  - b. Croydon Half Marathon donations. The following donations from the CHM surplus have been agreed. £1,000 to Sandilands, £828.00 to Cancer Research UK (Mayor's charity), St Christophers and GoodGym. £250.00 each to Tennis, Croydon Running Sisters and the Scouts. Total donations of £4,234.
- 5. Socials
  - a. The Committee thanked LF and HL for their work on the social calendar.
- 6. Kit Officer NJ
  - a. Old stock. NJ looking to continue reducing old stock.
  - b. It is likely that the first option in the new webshop will be for short sleeved T shirts.
  - c. It was agreed to donate stock with the old Striders logo to charity. NJ to see if an overseas charity can take this kit.
- 7. Club Runs All
  - **a.** Croydon Harriers. There was a discussion around offering CH members access to our marathon training runs.
  - b. Group 0 and Group 1. It has been noted that there has been a reduction in the number of runners/leaders in Group 0 and 1.
- 8. Swimming

a. RP reported that we have 5 regular Striders but the Amphibians involvement means that this is currently breaking even financially.

## 9. Triathlon & multisports - BS

- a. Open Water swimming. BS had emailed the club in April re an open water session at Tilgate Park Watersports.

## 10. Marathon Training

a. The Committee expressed thanks to all leaders who have set and led the marathon schedules, both winter and summer. Much positive feedback has been received for both.
